The No Surprises Act of 2021, was created to help protect patients from receiving surprise medical bills when seeking medical emergency services or certain services from out-of-network providers. This Act requires health care facilities and providers to provide patients and the public with notice of the No Surprises Act and its requirements. Absolute Health Chiropractic works diligently to comply with all current laws. It has always been our policy to work with patients to help them understand our fee schedule and any expected patient responsibility prior to the commencement of a care plan.

As such, our office posts a menu of available services and current pricing in the lobby and will provide all out-of-network patients with a Good Faith Estimate outlining the anticipated costs associated with any recommendation for care.
